Ageing Prosthetics - 11th, 12th & 13th March

Making realistic ageing appliances is an art form, and the range of age makeup is huge from adding a few years to a few hundred.

Extensive old-age makeup can use a lot of moulds and materials making it a difficult thing to accomplish without a studio set up. So, to make this relevant to the home-worker we will sculpt on a provided face cast and transform them to simple-to-make flat appliances.

This workshop concentrates on creating some simple yet effective prosthetics such as cheeks, eyebags, necks and foreheads to create realistic ageing effects. You'll take your moulds with you, so you can create endless makeups using them again and again.







Ageing Prosthetics Workshop is three day hands-on practical class which covers creating sculpting on a lifecast, floating off to create flat moulds and applying silicone gel filled appliances made from them.

The workshop covers:

- The ageing process.
- Sculpting on a lifecast, creating correct form and texture.
- Floating pieces off to make flat appliances.
- Moulding & casting appliances.
- · Application & colouring.
